At each sitting, ask God to enlighten your heart and change you through His truths. Read slowly and thoughtfully. Write down thoughts and highlight things that grab you.

With notebook in hand,

- 1) keep a list of the characteristics of a follower
- 2) and identify areas where you may need to grow in your own life.
- 3) Note for group discussion truths that jump off the page at you.

Just a few extra topics to pause and reflect:

CHAPTER 1

What emotions did you feel upon reading Ayan's story? (pg. 1-5) Platt says there are two responses to Ayan's question, "How do I become a Christian," but only one response is the truth. Why we tend to offer the first response instead of the second response that Platt describes? (pg. 2)

What does repentance look like? (pg. 19-24)

CHAPTER 2

Describe the pursuit by God and the great invitation of God toward humans.

In light of God's pursuing us and inviting us, what is our responsibility in salvation? (pg. 47-48)

CHAPTER 3

What is the difference between superficial religion and supernatural regeneration?

While contemplating pgs 67-73, that the natural overflow of following Jesus is to tell others, to make disciples, to be "fishers of men," did you shrink back from this? Are you compelled to fulfill your life purpose of making disciples? If not, what is holding you back? How can you overcome it?

CHAPTER 5

Chapter 5 focuses on what it means to be a child of God. What did this chapter stir within your soul as you realize the Father's delight in you? How has this spawned your true pleasure in Him, your desire for Him?

CHAPTER 6

How do we stay on track with God's will for our lives in the day-to-day things? (pg. 132)

What is God's overarching will for your life? (pg. 133-148)
